THE FIRST AMENDMENT:

- A) Think about the five freedoms of the First Amendment. How can you exercise each of the rights protected in the First Amendment in school?
- B) Read the article about the Hong Kong protests and explain which rights found in the First Amendment are being violated and why this is unacceptable and/or dangerous to a society.

THE DANGERS OF CENSORSHIP

- A) Read the article on the Denver area school district that is censoring some parts of the history text. Use this to discuss the dangers of censorship.
- B) Choose one of the quotes from the list to explain the dangers of censorship. Incorporate the quote into your explanation.

THE RIGHT TO READ

- A) Read the article on why *The Fault in Our Stars* was banned in Riverside, CA. Write a counterargument, addressing the reasons the book was banned.
- B) Considering the book you read for BBW, address the censors' issues by writing a counterargument. For example, if censors have issues with profanity, sexual situations and racist comments, what would you say to the censors on why these are appropriate/necessary for the novel. BE SPECIFIC TO YOUR NOVEL. USE SPECIFIC CHALLENGES TO YOUR BOOK (you already did the due diligence on this section).
