# The Requirements

## Building Permit:

- Tulsa County, Oklahoma requires a permit for churches and other public buildings
- Average approval time is one to two weeks.
- The building process requires multiple inspections.

- 96 feet long
- 34 feet wide
- Top Tower:
  - 18 feet tall by 6 feet by 6 feet
- Total Area 3,264 square feet
