

### **Collage**

- 1. Place the name of book and author in the center of the collage.**
- 2. Cover the entire sheet with no white paper showing.**
- 3. Use magazines. May use Internet images, original art or words but must be mixed with magazine.**
- 4. Embed t.e.—at least ten citations to explain why you chose what you chose for your visuals.**
- 5. Options to fill white space—more pictures, words, colored paper, glitter, paint, etc.**
- 6. Attention is given to appearance and overall aesthetic. This is a visual product.**
- 7. More than 10 images, words and phrases should be presented, but you only write about 10.**

### **Gifts**

- 1. Gifts must be literal.**
- 2. Embed t.e.—at least nine citations to explain each gift.**
- 3. Three gifts per character.**
- 4. Include images of gifts. May be drawn or found.**
- 5. Write like a card or a letter.**
- 6. Do not repeat gifts.**

### **Soundtrack**

- 1. Nine songs or artist total.**
- 2. At least one piece of t.e. per song/artist explanation.**
- 3. Acknowledge connection to song or artist with lyric citation or description of artist or song to aid in explanation.**
- 4. Embed t.e.—at least nine citations to explain choices.**

### **Storyboard**

- 1. Should be in color unless black/white or pencil drawings are a stylistic choice and show evidence of shading, detail and contrast.**
- 2. Embed t.e.—at least eight citations to explain drawings.**
- 3. Include at least one piece of t.e. per drawing/caption.**
- 4. Doesn't have to be on a poster.**
- 5. Paragraph explains relevance of drawing.**
