A.C.C.E. Strategy

A—Address—*Answer or address your “case,” the prompt, your thesis, or your conclusion.*

C—Context—*Provide brief context that set up the text evidence.*

C—Cite—*Embed “golden” pieces of T.E.*

E—Explain—*Provide commentary (C.M.) to prove your analysis. C.M. is your opinion justifying your ideas.*

Objection!
